### **Department of Canadian Heritage**

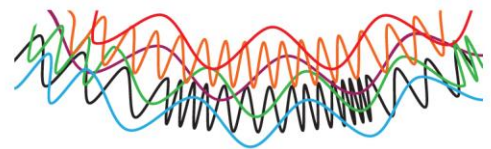
